
MIND MAPPING SAMPLE

Here is a sample of a completed mind mapping exercise **based on one of the assessments from the web page**. I chose a Video assessment example from the list for a Spanish course. Note the headings I included. (You may also include a short narrative with the image if you so desire.



1. The assessment aligns with the course objective being assessed and provides the learners with an opportunity to showcase their ability to communicate in the target language in a non-threatening environment.

2. Another strength of this assignment is the multiple opportunities for feedback created by allowing both the instructors and two of the students' peers to comment on the video produced.

3. It was also good that the rubric as well as a sample of a completed activity are provided for students.

4. The assessment aligned with principle 7 from the reading. The teacher provided clear instructions and a rubric to guide the assignment.

5. The assessment also aligned with principle 1 and 8. The assessment required students to speak in the target language and to comment on each other's videos allowing them to also use their listening skills.

6. The main objective of the course was to develop students' communication skills and the assignment allowed students to demonstrate the extent they accomplished this objective through the videos. The rubric also provided clear guidelines for assessing the different aspects of the speaking skills aligned with the objective of the course.
